Teachers bring your student leaders to Hillary House to learn about Sir Edmund Hillary’s life and legacy and to workshop ideas about leadership and service.



Hillary House is ‘the house that Ed built’ and where he lived throughout his adult life. After his death in 2008, it was moved from Remuera and re-sited in the grounds of Sir Edmund Hillary Collegiate School in Otara. After being restored, the House was opened in 2014 as a leadership centre and place of heritage in Aotearoa New Zealand.

Hillary House Student Leadership Workshops

Learning Objectives

1. Exposure for student leaders to the actual house that Sir Ed built where he conceived his dreams and planned his expeditions, and to learn about its journey from Remuera to Otara
2. Engagement with an iconic figure of New Zealand’s history and inspiration in shared leadership
3. Foster students’ ability to set and share worthy goals and consider how to celebrate achievement milestones in their contexts
4. Foster collaborative teamwork throughout the visit in the spirit of Hillary House
