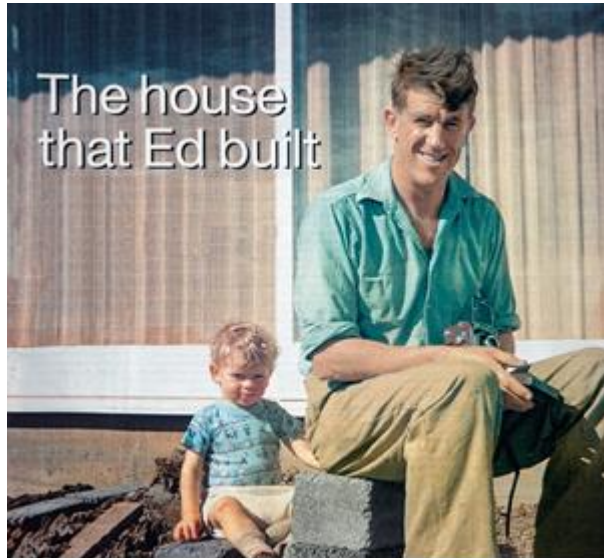


“... if the walls of the house could talk, they would tell stories of people doing extraordinary things and we hope those who visit Ed *Hillary's* house will be inspired too...”

Hillary House is 'the house that Ed built' and where he lived throughout his adult life. After his death in 2008, it was moved from Remuera and re-sited in the grounds of Sir Edmund Hillary Collegiate School in Otara. After being restored, the House was opened in 2014 as a leadership centre and place of heritage in Aotearoa New Zealand.
